







































































**Salt Cravings:** If Sodium doesn't eat foods with high salt contents, he is drastically weaker. Consuming salt does not make him stronger.

Liquid Hair: Mercury's hair is made of liquid mercury, and she can manipulate its size and strength, being able to slip her hair through the tiniest of holes. Her hair has a secondary effect where if someone consumes it, Mercury can temporarily mind control them.





Liquid Hands: With hands made of liquid bromine, Bromine has superhuman strength, can burn anything, and expand his hands out up to 20x his body length. He is also able to withstand freezing temperatures, and can regulate the liquid bromine in his body as to not overheat. The enhanced strength in his hands made working out easier for Bromine, and as a result, the sleeves of any shirt can't accommodate the bulging muscles in his arms.

His liquid hands are a permanent part of his body, so he struggles with handling small objects or doing precise actions. Imagine it being like wearing oven mitts for the rest of your life.

Plant Manipulation: As long as Boron can find a plant or vegetation somewhere, she can manipulate its size, appearance, what it excretes, etc. The larger the plant, the harder she has to focus to control it, and she may collapse if she overexerts herself.



Vibrant Glow: Neon can illuminate his skin like a light, able to change colors and brightness at any speed. He can use this ability to temporarily blind people, but he prefers to use it to enhance the raves he hosts.



Intoxicating Charm: By flirting with others,
Antimony can mind control people into a state
of submissiveness. Using this, she can
command others to fight for her, but the
person's strength is not increased, so unless
Antimony commands them wisely, they're
gonna get hurt.

Diamond Skin: Carbon can create a diamond coat covering any part of her body, providing sharp armor that is almost impossible to break. She can create these diamonds in seconds, but the process of removing them takes intense focus, so she usually only turns parts of her body into diamonds in small sections.



Toxic Fluids: Any liquid excretion from Polonium contains powerful chemicals that can melt anything and inflict an incredible stinging pain. She can't control creating these liquids, but she is prone to get very sweaty during any physical excursion. Her clothes are specially

tailored to not melt off her.

Hyper Focus: If Silicon is intensely interested in something, they are able to master the skill in seconds. However, if they lose interest and move onto something else, all knowledge of that previous interest is gone. Silicon uses their power to focus on building tech and machinery that can aid the other Elements and the HO.

Future Sight: Platinum is able to see hundreds of possible futures at any given time, and by closing his eyes, his visions become clearer. Sometimes his visions can become unclear and distorted when he is intoxicated or under a great deal of stress, causing him extreme

migraines.






Friendship Power: As long as people believe Hydrogen can do something, her physical strength is increased dramatically, becoming even stronger if crowds of people cheer her on. At the same time, if she is booed or jeered, she becomes weaker. She counters this by maintaining friendships with multiple groups, having audio recordings of people cheering her on, and working out consistently in case she needs to rely on her own strength.

The effects of being believed in stack up, and Hydrogen needs to work off any remaining power she has in her after a fight or else something like gently knocking on a door will send it flying two blocks down.

Hydrogen is the leader of the Elements and the President of Periodicity 118 HQ.



A New Day (Episode One/Pilot): Sodium is given the chance to finally shine as an Element after receiving his very first mission. However, when he realizes he is tasked with stopping the strongest Element to exist, Bromine, from destroying a bridge, Sodium pieces together that his first mission might be his last.

Can You Spell 'Periodicity?': To keep spirits up with some friendly competition, Hydrogen hosts the 5th Annual Element Spelling Bee, hoping that Bromine will not show up so things run smoothly. Bromine shows up and things do not go smoothly.

Have You Seen This Rival?: Bromine can't find Sodium after he didn't show up for their scheduled fight. Unable to process this unexcused absence, Bromine goes through the five stages of grief believing Sodium died, or worse, replaced him as his one and only rival.

A Rock in a Sweaty Place: Carbon and Polonium are put on a mission together where they learn that each of their assumptions on the other are wrong, and their relationship blossoms.

**Don't Look**: Silicon does everything in their control to surprise Platinum for his birthday without him being spoiled by his own power.

Bromine the Motorbike: Mercury's motorcycle is damaged, so she ditches her scheduled shift at the HQ and uses her skills as a private investigator to find out what happened.

## **EPISODES**

Her Mission: Hydrogen notices that Tungsten is being too hard on herself with her workout routines, and after finally understanding why, takes her under her wing with the hopes of changing Tungsten's outlook on her second life.

Locked Out: The Elements are mysteriously locked out of the HQ and have to think critically about how to use their powers to get in without causing too much damage.

Glow Stick: Antimony has to thread the needle between using her power to make her date with Neon go without a problem while making sure to not cross any boundaries.


**Infestation:** Boron has to deal with unwelcome guests in her greenhouse when it seems every Element has decided that it is the place to hang out.

I Need to Change: Platinum is trapped in a time loop where he needs to perform the correct actions or risk the safety of Silicon and the other Elements.


























































## **CIGARETTE BREAKS**
